## \$20,000 TOWARDS THE KFF CARAVAN

---

Work is already underway on refurbishing a 1960's caravan to be used by the KFF as a family hub at community events across the school. Extensive work has already been done by volunteers in the areas of electrics, panel beating, painting, graphics and interior carpentry. Further funding will allow the purchase of a canvas awning, windows, furnishings and electrical goods for the caravan.
