The following fees are required to be paid in full by 4 November 2019:

- Tuition Fee for the whole year
- Activity and Development Contribution and medical insurance for whole year
- Alumni Fee (entry year only)
- Homestay for the whole year

This will provide adequate time for the issue/renewal of Student Visas by the New Zealand Immigration Service. Student Visas must be presented to the Admissions Manager before International Students can begin their studies at Kristin School.

Please note that the fees are not refundable within the first 12 months for international students who wish to transfer to domestic fees as a result of gaining permanent residency or a work permit during that period. In subsequent years of enrolment both notice and evidence of the change of status must be sent to the Executive Principal a full term in advance before a change of fees can be granted to apply to the subsequent term.

A Development Contribution of NZ\$1,150 per annum will be applied to a maximum of two students per family.
